

## Government Aizawl North College Analysis of Alumni Feedback 2020-21


Alumni of the college are important stakeholders, who venture out into the world and combat the challenges using knowledge, skills and abilities imbibed in the campus. The college administration and other committees are maintaining constant and healthy contact with the alumni. The institution garner responses and inputs from alumni on different aspects viz. environment, infrastructure, fee structure, faculty, quality of supporting materials, training & placement, Library, recent development, relevance of curriculum in their current jobs, that reflect the institution's working efficiency so that further improvements can be made wherever needed. This also helps to identify its strengths and weaknesses, and build stronger capabilities for better performance on all aspects. Feedbacks on the above aspects were gathered from member of alumni of the college and the results have been tabulated and analyzed.

**Sex-wise Respondents and their Subject-wise distribution:** Out of the total respondents, 56.7 percents are male and 43.3 percent are female. Out of the total students enrooled, 25.4 percent students are opted Education subjects, 23.9 are admitted to study Mizo subjects, 20.9 percent opted History, 17.9 percent choose Geography papers, 6 percent of the total respondents choose Economics for their optional papers, and the remaining percentages are distributed between English and Political science.







How would you rate your satisfaction with the college with these parameters?

#### 1. Environment




While 42.6 percent agreed that the educational environment of the institution is good, 48.5 percent announced that it is better than good. It is noticeable that while negligible percent of the students reponded saying the current environment is below average, more than 20 percent acknowledge it as excellent. Looking at the responses from the respondents, the condition of environment of the campus is satisfactorily good for study.




**Infrastructure:** The infrastructure includes classroom and related materials like benches, desk, etc, restroom, hallways, teaching support tangible goods, The infrastructural setup of the institution, though not up to the mark, improving till date. Less than 5 percent of respondents acknowledge it as excellent, while half of the respondents say that it is good and 35 percent say it very good.



# 3. Faculty 68 responses




**Faculty:** The faculty comprises teachers in the department of Mizo, History, English, Education, Economics, Political Science and Geography. Alumni responded that the overall performance of the various faculties is very good. Out of the total respondents, as much as 32.4 percent recognized it as excellent, while 38.2 percent recognized as very and 26.5 percent is good. It is noticeable that only 2.9 percent reported it as average.




**Fee structure:** Fee structure is prepared by the Higher Education Department, Government of Mizoram and the institution is permitted to add fees on examination only.41.2 percent of the respondent say that the fee structure is affordable; while 25 percent recognised it as excellent and 25 percent as very good. Only 8.8 percent rated the fee structure as average.


#### 4. Fee structure




**Quality of support material:** The educational support materials includes teaching aids, laboratory, classroom equipments, etc. 45 percent of the respondents rated that the quality of educational supporting materials are good, while 13.2 percent recognized it as excellent, 29.4 percent as very good, 10.3 percent average. It is negligible that 1 percent of the respondents rated poor.







**Training & Placement:** Almost half of the respondents aknowledge, Training & Placement status of the institution, it as good, 22.1 percent as very good, while 11.8 percent as excellent. 14.7 percent say that the condition of training and placement is average and as much as 7.4 percent reported it as poor.






8. Development in the College in recent years are appreciative. 67 responses


### 9. Relevance of curriculum in your Job
