



QUIT INDIA DAY



The Department of History & Equal Opportunity Cell, IQAC, Govt. Aizawl North College jointly organized Webinar on 'Observation of Quit India Day' on 9 August, 2021. It was one of the series of events to be organized by the Govt. of India to commemorate the 75th Anniversary of India's independence. The programmes are held under 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav' which literally means 'potion of life' (elixir) of independence, inspiration of freedom fighters, new ideas and pledges.
