

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



In recognition of the mutual benefits of scholastic interaction between the two institutions, and in the spirit of mutual cooperation, development and understanding among both the faculties and students, Department of Geography, Government Aizawl North College and Department of Geography, Government Hnahthial College agreed to this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for the purpose of Virtual Faculty Exchange Programme.

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

- (i) The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of both institutions,
- (ii) Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
- (iii) The exchange of academic materials and publications,
- (iv) Conducting lectures,
- (v) Participating in seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions,
- (vi) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work.

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of one Semester commencing from effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review. This MoU is effective from I<sup>st</sup> January 2022 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022.
