Department of Mizo, Govt. Aizawl North College Dilzawl, Field Trip April 22, 2023

We departed around 10:00 a.m. from Aizawl and reached Dapchhuach around 1:00 p.m. From Dapchhuah, a boat was hired to carry heavy baggage and send two students along with it. The rest continued on the trek.

Dilzawl was established in 1974. It is under Hmunpui Village Council and under a section of the Hmunpui YMA branch. The only way to enter the village is by boat. After walking for about three and a half hours, we reach the village.

The next day, i.e., April 22, around 11:00 a.m., we visited different institutions within the village. They have two schools, which are UPS (upper primary school) and Salvation School. The Upper Primary School is under the SSA Mission, Mamit District. It consists of 50 students and four teachers. The Salvation School has 63 students and 4 teachers. It was established in 2002. The teacher's salary at Salvation School was provided by the Salvation Church itself. We had dinner around 4:05 p.m.

On April 23, at 9:00 a.m., we departed from Dilzawl to Dapchhuah by boat. After arriving at Dapchhuah, we proceeded to Aizawl. On the way, we had lunch at Rawpuichhip. We reached Aizawl around 8:00 p.m.
