
ONLINE LECTURE ON POPULAR CULTURE: INTRODUCTORY PERSPECTIVES

The Department conducted an online lecture on the theme of *Popular Culture: Introductory Perspectives* on 22nd July 2022. The resource person for the lecture was Dr. Cherrie L.Chhangte, who is presently residing in Illinois, United States.
